

REQUIREMENTS FOR A LAWN SPRINKLER PERMIT

1. Provide two (2) copies of a recent Plat of Survey indicating the proposed location of sprinkler heads and backflow preventor – RPZ and type.
2. Permit Application must be completed and signed including permanent real estate index number (PIN) and construction cost.
3. No sprinkler heads are allowed in the right-of-way, easements, detention area or flood plain/floodway.
 - a. Maintain a 5’ setback to lot lines, sprinkler heads to spray away from adjacent property.
 - b. House connection to be type “L” copper.

NOTE:

New construction site requires final topographic survey approval by Engineering Department before sprinkler permit is issued.

RPZ Valves need to be inspected annually.
