The minutes of the March 10, 2015 meeting were approved and submitted to the City Clerk for official stamp.

Presentation by Steven Cutaia: Steve stated that the last heavy rains caused some flooding which subsided within 24 hrs. The Greater Metropolitan Reclamation Center has been involved in reinforcing the embankment of McDonald Creek in the Woodlawn Trails area. A resident in Prospect Court contacted the City with a concern that the new home construction in his area which is at a higher elevation than his home is causing increased flooding problem on his property. Steve made a site visit and stated that the new construction does not affect the resident's property. Steve shared a report with the committee on the Public Works status report and future projects.

UPDATES FROM THE COMMITTEE:

Jerry Sredl visited the Lake Claire Estates after the recent heavy rains and stated there was no apparent flooding problems. The house in foreclosure in the Willow and Elm street area has not been sold. A letter was sent to the contact party noted on the foreclosure notice and no response has been received as of this date.
