



Satellite Antenna Guideline

Antennas under 3' in diameter are exempt
(Disclaimer: This guide may not be all inclusive, additional regulations may apply)



What to Submit

- *Completed application.
- *Plat of survey (3 copies)
- *Provide manufactures' installation instructions
- *Provide manufactures' specs
- *Provide anchoring detail in detail (on the home or concrete pad)
- *Provide detail of required screening
- *Confirm clarify in writing that this proposed structure is NOT in a floodplain, easement or floodway

Rules & Restrictions

- *No antennas are allowed in the easements
- *Antennas over 120' from the front lot line may be 5' from the side and or rear lot lines, otherwise must be 15' clear and a maximum of 15' in height
- *Antennas over 3' in diameter require screening
