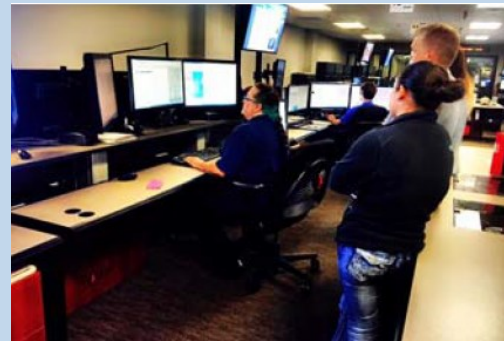
COURSE INFORMATION:
