Inspections

*Inspections are scheduled for A.M. or P.M. Monday through Friday with 24 hours advance notice. Call 847-398-6070 x 211 before 5:00 P.M. the day before you want your inspection. Same day re-inspections are not available.

*Call J.U.L.I.E. (800-892-0123) before digging.

*Final inspection required with a RPZ certificate

What to Submit

*Completed application.

*Plat of plats survey (3 copies)

*3 copies of a site plan showing the proposed exact location; this may be written on a plat of survey

*Provide manufactures' installation instructions

*Provide manufactures' specs, include the required RPZ type

*Irrigation contractors must have the following:

- Illinois Irrigation License
- Bond or License Permit and liability insurance
- One licensed plumber on contract retainer for every five (5) irrigation installers (provide state license)

*Confirm clarify in writing that this proposal is NOT in a floodplain, easement, or floodway

Rules & Restrictions

*No sprinklers allowed in the easements or Right-of-Ways

*RPZ are required to be installed and inspected annually by a private state licensed plumber

*Maintain a 5' setback from the lot lines

*Sprinkler heads are to spray inward and not toward neighboring properties

*The house connection shall be galvanized or type "L" copper

*New construction sites require final topographic survey approval by the Engineering Department before the sprinkler permit is issued

*New construction requires a final topographical survey approved by the city engineer prior permit issuance
